Programs

SCHG brings skilled artists and weavers to speak on a variety of topics. Each year we offer programs and workshops that cover a range of topics that will be of interest to our membership. We try to balance programs and workshops in three areas: Creativity, with a focus to weaving; Weaving techniques such as basketry or tapestry weaving; and General Skills, like using color with weaving or finishing techniques.

SCHG programs and workshops are held in on the second Saturday of each month, September through June, in Room 110 of the Art Building of Los Angeles Valley College, 5800 Fulton Ave. (the corner of Burbank Blvd. and Fulton Ave. in Valley Glen). Parking is in the Faculty Parking Lot C, next to the building. Programs begin at 9 a.m. Saturday workshops begin at 1:00 p.m. and Sunday workshops begin at 9:00 a.m.

SCHG has a long tradition that influences programs. For instance, instead of a program in November, we host a Weaving and Fiber Festival on the first Sunday. For the December meeting our members celebrate the holidays with a potluck array of homemade goodies.
