Traditional to Faux: Dyeing to Weave
 workshop with Kathleen Wain

Kathleen has been working with fabric for over 30 years, first as a theatre educator and costume designer and more recently as a fabric designer. She has been Dyeing, spinning, and weaving for over ten years. Her passions include kkat, Shibori and researching the history of the fabric arts. Kathleen's work has been exhibited across the country. She has been a university professor and costume historian. At present, she teaches weaving, spinning and dyeing for adult education, as well as young children in the classroom. Kathleen also harvests her own organic cotton trees and loves to dye and spin their yield. Kathleen holds a MFA in Theatrical Design from the University of Texas at Austin.

Kathleen will demonstrate combining techniques of Japanese Shibori with modern loom-controlled Shibori. You will have the opportunity to learn some simple shibori stitching and tying methods that you can add to your weaving repertoire. With these fascinating techniques, you'll be dyeing to weave! Both traditional and faux shibori will be used to create your one of a kind woven fabric. When you weave with shibori, you end up with fabric with a dye-resist of your woven pattern. Participants must know how to dress a loom and produce a plain weave. Maximum enrollment 12. Kathleen will supply 10/2 cotton warp & weft @ cost and instructions.

Material fees include weft pattern thread, dye supplies, handouts, cotton warp chain (to produce a 72" scarf plus samples), and cotton weft thread.
